It is not available at the centers.

**Will there be a charge to get the vaccine at participating vaccine clinics?**

The cost of the vaccine is covered at 100 percent for BHP members.

**What if it is determined that I need the COVID-19 Test?**

Test location availability is changing on a daily basis. Your health care provider will give you instructions on where to go for the test. Butler Advantage offers rapid testing on-site with a single swab for Flu A/B and COVID-19. You can also see a list of test providers on the ODH website.

**Coronavirus symptoms prompting an Emergency Room visit:**

Go to the ER if you having extreme symptoms such as high fever, vomiting, difficulty breathing or a combination of severe symptoms. If possible, phone ahead so that precautionary measures can be taken.
